Helpful Hints

Getting Started

Thank you for hosting an Operation Backpack supply drive! Whether this is your first time or you've hosted before, this guide will walk you through what to expect and how to make your drive successful.

Step 1: Decide What Type of Drive You Want to Host

You can customize your drive based on what works best for your group:

- Full supply drive: Collect a variety of items from the full supply list.
- **Focused drive:** Collect one or two specific items (for example, just backpacks, or just crayons and markers).
- Monetary drive: Collect financial donations, which Phoenix Family will use to purchase high-need items.

Tip: Drives that offer both supplies and monetary donations tend to be the most successful.

Step 2: Choose Your Dates and Location

- We recommend running your drive for 2–3 weeks.
- Make sure your donation bins are placed in high-traffic, easy-to-access locations.
- Post clear signage so people know what items are needed and how long the drive runs.

Step 3: Promote Your Drive

- Let people know what you're doing and how they can help:
- Use the email templates included in this toolkit.
- Post flyers in common areas.
- Share on your company's intranet, newsletter, or social media channels.
- Send out periodic reminders during the drive.
- Consider adding a little fun friendly competitions between departments or teams can help boost participation!

Step 4: Collect Donations

- Make sure your bins are monitored and emptied as needed.
- Keep participants updated on how the drive is going.
- If collecting checks, make them payable to Phoenix Family and keep them secure until the drive is complete.

Step 5: Deliver Donations

A Few Things to Keep in Mind

New items only: We cannot accept used or opened supplies.

Stick to the supply list: This helps ensure each child receives the items they need most.

Deadlines: Donations need to be received no later than August 5, 2025 to allow time for sorting, packaging, and distribution before school starts. We recommend that you end your supply drive by August 4, 2025.

Host FAQ: Operation Backpack 2025

What items should we collect?

We ask hosts to focus on the most-needed school supplies. A full list is included in your toolkit, but top priorities include backpacks, wide-rule notebooks, pocket folders, 3-ring binders, pencils, erasers, glue sticks, crayons, colored pencils, and supply boxes.

Can we collect used items?

No. All donated items must be new and unopened.

Can we accept monetary donations?

Yes! Checks can be made payable to Phoenix Family and turned in with your donation delivery. Phoenix Family uses monetary donations to purchase additional supplies where shortages exist.

How long should our drive run?

We recommend 2–3 weeks. Please plan to complete your drive and deliver donations by August 5, 2025, so that we have time to sort and distribute supplies before school begins.


What if we want to do a fun competition or activity during the drive?



It's that time of year — and we're kicking off our Operation Backpack supply drive to support Phoenix Family and help local kids start school ready to learn.
